JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Leadership and Planning:

- Work with assigned Children Department representatives in detail summer program planning tasks
- Provide on-site support and supervision of all summer workers and youth volunteers

Content Preparation:

- Plan and acquire teaching materials for all events, i.e. summer bible camp, Sunday school, bedtime stories for kindergarteners and toddlers, activity camp as well as other programs as directed
- Identify, prioritize and recommend materials and equipment needed for children's events

Event Execution: (depending on pandemic situation, events could be conducted in either inperson, Zoom based or in hybrid mode)

- Work with Summer Program Coordinator, Program Assistants and youth volunteers in planning, and running
 - o Summer Bible Camp activities between July 19 to July 31
 - Sunday School activities every Sunday
 - o Bedtime Stories sessions
 - Activity Camp sessions
- Plan and supervise all classroom practices and preparations whenever necessary and appropriate, i.e. room decoration, lesson plans, daily schedules, routines, and transitions to assure their adherence to MBC Children Ministry expectations
- Plan and supervise all teaching materials acquisition and preparation, i.e. craft preparation, game preparation, online activities, visual presentations and in person activities (if feasible)
- Plan and supervise all events, rehearsals and debriefings
- Plan and supervise all singing, story time, content delivery, arts and crafts, games and activities as well as in-class discussions
- Supervise and oversee class disciplines
- Plan, supervise and participate in summer events, rehearsals and debriefings
- Work with assigned Children Department representatives and fellow summer workers to execute programs to collaborate with participants' parents
- Provide technical support when required

Administrative Tasks:

- Attend training sessions, staff meetings, and parent meetings as requested
- Record and monitor participants' attendance in all programs
- Provide feedbacks and observations on summer programs and participants to Children Department representatives and fellow summer program workers regularly
- Provide work related feedbacks and observations to fellow summer program workers when necessary
- Work with Children Department representatives to prepare MBC facilities for Children Ministry reopening
